


Criterion 2c Criterion 3a Criterion 3c	Conduct at least one unit meeting dedicated to the purpose of completing the outcomes assessment feedback loop using collected data. This meeting should be conducted during 2005-2006 and will be a midpoint (mid-program) analysis.	12/31/05	
Criterion 5a	Define the constituency (stakeholders) of the Graduate Studies in Management program. Update the MNU catalog mission statement for GSM with this definition.	10/31/05	
Criterion 3b	Provide evidence of systemic training of all adjunct faculty. Possible evidence could include: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Adjunct contract language requiring training, and/or - Letter to adjuncts encouraging them to attend university sponsored professional development for adjuncts. 	9/30/05 and 1/31/06	
Criterion 3c	Written plan to increase doctorally qualified faculty to sixty-seven percent.	5/31/06
